Regarding Lift tickets, Group Lift ticket pricing will not be available till later in the year. (We are assuming it to be \$120-\$160 per day!) We are recommending everyone purchase a 4-5-6 day Epic Day pass.

EXAMPLE

If you purchased a **4 day – Epic day pass for \$266**, your lift ticket cost would be **\$67 per day**, you could do 3 days at Heavenly, 1 day at Kirkwood, 1 day at Palisades, **Total Cost \$1,221** (Air not included)

If you purchased a **5 day - Epic day pass for \$322**, your lift ticket cost would be **\$65 per day**, you could do 4 days at Heavenly, 1 day at Kirkwood, **Opt-Out** of the 1 day at Palisades, **Total Cost \$1,077** (Air not included)

<u>Lake Tahoe, Forest Suites Resort</u> Just steps from the Heavenly Village Gondola, and Nevada Casinos, and a few short blocks from the crystal clear waters of Lake Tahoe, <u>Forest Suites Resort</u> is the ideal location for our next ski club, ski adventure. **Forest Suites Resort**, has **newly renovated condos**, <u>Amenities</u> include, two year-round outdoor hot tubs. High Speed Wireless Internet, several coin operated, self-use laundry facilities, Fitness Center (open from 7am to 10pm) Daily Hot breakfast buffet (6:30am-10am). The hotel elevation is 6,230 feet.

Heavenly Village Gondola is only a few minutes' walk (600 ft.) from the hotel. Also close by are Restaurants, Shopping, Live Theater, Cinema, and Ice Rink. Just (800 Ft) away from the Hotel is the Raley's Grocery Store, with (food, beer, wine and liquor). (Open from 7am-10pm.) There is a nearby hiking trails, plus four (4) - 24 hour Casinos, Harrah's, Harvey's, Bally's, and Hard Rock. The Heavenly Village is extensive, you'll be quite happy with the après/shopping options in the village, and there are a few fun art galleries, live music somewhere in the village most nights, numerous delicious restaurants, fun bars, and even a speakeasy, and a magic show! (The adult-only magic shows are quite hilarious.) There are a few fun options just across the street from the village as well, like the mini-golf bar and axthrowing.

Heavenly

The biggest playground in Lake Tahoe, Heavenly offers the most bang for your buck with some of the best views of Lake Tahoe around. Heavenly is located in South Lake Tahoe and is a major player on the **Epic pass**, This Mountain is great for advanced and intermediate skiers. Heavenly has some of the hardest terrain and expanses of groomed cruiser runs. Everyone will find something they enjoy here. Heavenly offers 97 trails that include everything from open bowls to perfect groomers, world-class terrain parks, extensive snowmaking and a new tubing hill. Within the complex are 30 chairlifts accessing 4,800 acres of skiing and snowboarding. With 3,500 vertical feet of descent, Heavenly is known as the largest vertical drop on the West Coast. Base elevation is 6,540 feet, and the summit is at 10,067 feet. One fun aspect to Heavenly is that you can ski across the state line between California and Nevada. See Trail Map.

Kirkwood

Kirkwood is one of those ski areas that still has the welcoming atmosphere of days gone by. Filled with tons of little stashes and mini chutes, Kirkwood is a fantastic place to practice for steeper descents elsewhere. Another player on the **Epic Pass**, Kirkwood is known for its super-fun tree skiing and safe conditions when storms rage. Within its 2,300 skiable acres, Kirkwood may have the most amount of terrain features for its size, making playtime exponential. To access the goods, it has 15 lifts and 86 trails. The mountain has a base elevation that is pretty up there, at 7,800 feet, and a summit of 9,800 feet, making Kirkwood a sure bet for great snow when the temperatures are iffy. Their longest run is 2.5 miles long, and the terrain is split into 12% beginner, 30% intermediate, 38% advanced and 20% expert. See Trail Map

Palisades / Alpine Meadows

Another major player when it comes to full-scale ski resorts (but on the **Ikon pass**), Palisades / Alpine Meadows. Palisades has had a reputation for decades for offering some of the best terrain available in Lake Tahoe. Dating back about a decade, <u>Palisades</u> (formally known as Squaw Valley) used to be its own endeavor, but then <u>Alpine Meadows</u> was acquired and now the two are one, giving skiers a huge amount of terrain to play on with just one pass. Since they are two different ski areas offering two different experiences, it is important to speak of them individually.

Alpine Meadows, is a fantastic ski area for learning the ropes before moving on to the big leagues. The ski area tends to get a little bit more snow than Palisades because of its location on the crest, and it can offer better early or spring skiing. Alpine Meadows has a base elevation of 6,835 feet and tops out at 8,637feet, with 2,400 skiable acres of terrain and a vertical rise of 1,802 feet. It has 13 lifts accessing the goods as well as one terrain park.

<u>Palisades</u> looks a bit different. Palisades does, indeed, offer some of the best steep skiing in the lower 48 states and ranks up there with the likes of Jackson Hole and Whistler, although its acreage doesn't quite equate, coming in at 3,600 acres of skiable terrain. Palisade's base elevation is 6,200 feet and summits at 9,050 feet, offering 2,850 vertical feet of drop. This is split into two terrain parks and 270 runs accessed via 26 lifts, of which 25% are beginner, 42.5% intermediate and 32.5% advanced/expert. The longest run is 3.2 miles. <u>See All Trail Maps</u>

NEW in 2023 will be the California Express Gondola connecting Palisades to Alpine Meadow, allowing guests to ski both mountains in one day, and making Palisades Tahoe the third largest ski area in North America.













Distance from the Hotel to Palisades / Alpine Meadows




Distance from the Hotel to Kirkwood Mountain Resort





Distance from the Hotel to the Heavenly Village Gondola ~600 ft







Distance from the hotel to the Raley's Grocery Store, with (food, beer, wine and liquor). (Open from 7am-10pm.) ~800 ft
