Val D'Isere is the premier location for skiing in Europe. With 25,000 acres of skiable terrain, Val D'Isere is composed of 3 ski areas: Solaise, Belvedere, and Glacier du Pissailas. And there is something for everyone from beginner to expert skier. Hotel Kandahar is on the main road situated between shops and restaurants, and less than a 5-min walk to the ski lifts.

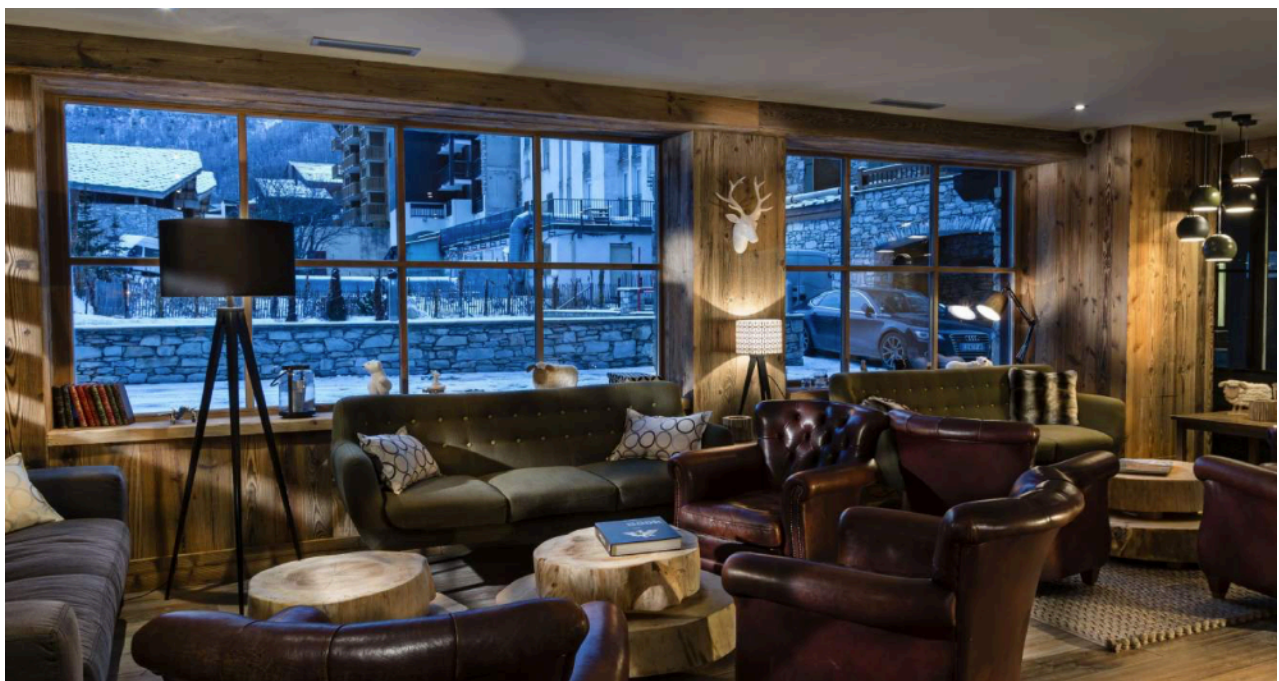

Hotel Kandahar

The Chalet style hotel is located a short walk from the ski slopes of the Bellevarde and Solaise mountains, in Val D'Iserre. It offers sauna and steam room, and rooms with balconies. Each of the quest rooms has a private bathroom and a TV, and some have mountain views. The Kandahar's restaurant, La Taverne d'Alsace, serves regional and brasserie-style cuisine. There is also a bar, with free wifi.

IMPORTANT DETAILS - Please read carefully!

1. BAGGAGE ALLOWANCE: INTERNATIONAL FLIGHTS: Before embarking on this tour it is important that each tour member be fully aware of the baggage restrictions. Specifically, Delta currently allows each passenger 1 checked piece not to exceed 50lbs or larger than 62" (L+W+D). One carry-on is also permitted but must be able to fit under the seat or in the overhead bin. Any luggage in addition to this will be subject to excess baggage charges which are charged PER FLIGHT, EACH WAY per bag, per flight. Please note you **will** be subject to excess baggage charges if you are over the limit. Please check with Delta Airlines regarding the updated baggage allowance which is subject to change at any time. **All baggage rules are subject to change by the airline.**

***Any excess baggage charges incurred by the airlines, bus companies or hotels are the sole responsibility of the passenger.**

2. GROUP SEATING on AIRLINE: It is customary for the airlines to allocate a section (**or block**) of seats when booking groups. It is understood that the group is usually seated in this block of seats and requests for aisle or window seats CAN NOT be accommodated due to the limitations required by the seat block. So please do not request. **NOTE: Exit row and/or bulkhead seating can only be assigned at the airport and may incur additional fees depending on the air carrier used.**

3. ENTRY REQUIREMENTS: All U. S. Citizens participating in this tour program are required to have a U. S. Passport valid for at least 6 months *beyond* the return date of the tour. Any non-U. S. Citizens participating in this tour must check with the appropriate consulate for all countries being visited and transited, to ensure that they have met all entry requirements. It is the participant's responsibility to be sure that all proper entry requirements are met and that they have all the appropriate documents necessary. The Airlines will not let you board the aircraft if your passport is EXPIRED.

4. LAND ONLY PASSENGERS: In the event participants choose air that is not part of the air arrangement as offered in the package, then the following conditions concerning "PPPI" passengers will apply. Such passengers are considered "Participants Pursuing Personal Itineraries" or **PPPI**. It is imperative that any and all participants arranging their own air be fully aware of the following facts pertaining to the tour program:

1. Transfers between airports and hotels are always arranged for the main group and are coordinated with the main group's flight itineraries.
2. The transfers also pick up and drop off only at airport terminals that are in the main group's itineraries. Transfers do not stop at alternate terminals for pick-ups or drop offs.
3. It is the responsibility of such PPPI passengers to coordinate their flights with the group and for them to be at the appointed place and time that the group is being picked up. **PLEASE NOTE THAT group airline itineraries can and do change. It is the responsibility for such PPPI passengers to coordinate with the group. As such we recommend you arrange your flight to arrive significantly BEFORE (even the day before) on arrival in Geneva, and departure AFTER the group departure.**
4. There can be no special arrangements made for PPPI passengers for alternate pickups or drop offs by the transfer companies involved.
5. All of the above is equally applicable to any luggage for such PPPI passengers.
6. The Tour Company cannot offer credit for transfers that are not being used in our packages.

5. CANCELLATIONS by Participant: In the event that you cancel your tour reservation, your right to a refund is limited because of the non-refundable expenses and deposits made on your behalf.

Regardless of when reservations are made, a participant may cancel **Only by Mail**, sent to the Trip Leader’s address listed on the trip form.

6. CANCELLATION and/or CHANGES by the ski club: Chagrin Valley Ski Club reserves the right to withdraw the tour, to refuse to accept or retain any person as a member of the tour at any time, or make changes in the published itinerary whenever in their sole judgment conditions warrant prior to departure time.

7. WAIVER: Each trip participant is required to sign a waiver prior to departure to hold harmless CVSC, the trip operator and the trip Chairpersons. This waiver must be sent to the trip leader along with the initial trip deposit.

8. PAYMENTS: Payments are due to the Tour Operator. Send checks to Holiday Ski Tours, 810 Belmar Plaza, Belmar, NJ 07719, please write “Chagrin valley Ski Club” somewhere on the outside of the envelope. Alternatively, payments can be made using a credit card (which will include a surcharge) by filling out a form. More information on payments will be emailed to you upon receipt of your online registration form. Deposits will be accepted until the trip is full. When trip is full, your name will be put on a waiting list until there is an opening. **Payments are due as stated on trip flyer above.** If balances are not received by those dates, the people on the waiting list will be given priority and **you will be considered to have canceled** and your deposit will automatically be forfeited.

9. TRIP CANCELLATION/INTERRUPTION INSURANCE: Trip cancellation insurance is available and is highly recommended. The premium depends on the amount of coverage desired and is based on the tour cost as indicated and will cover all non-refundable amounts in the event of a covered cancellation or trip interruption up to the amount of coverage selected, plus the following additional coverage.
